Chocolate Chip Cheeseball

1 8oz. cream cheese,	semisweet choc.
1/2 c. butter, softened	chips
3/4 c. confectioners' sugar	3/4 cup finely chopped pecans or semisweet choc. chips
2 tbsp. brown sugar	
1/4 tsp. vanilla extract	
3/4 cup miniature	

In a medium bowl, beat together cream cheese and butter until smooth. Mix in confectioners' sugar, brown sugar and vanilla. Stir in chocolate chips. Cover, and chill in the refrigerator for 2 hours. Shape chilled cream cheese mixture into a ball. Wrap with plastic, and chill in the refrigerator for 1 hour. Roll the cheese ball in finely chopped pecans or chocolate chips before serving.

Crustless Quiche

1/4 pound butter	1 package cream cheese -3 oz
1/2 c. flour	2 c. cottage cheese
6 large eggs	1 ts. baking powder
1 c. milk	1 tsp. salt
1 pound monterey jack cheese, cubed	1 tsp. sugar

Melt butter in small saucepan, add flour and cook until smooth. Beat eggs, add milk, cheese, baking powder, salt, sugar and butter-flour mixture. Stir until well blended. Pour into a well greased 9x13 pan. Bake uncovered at 350 for 45 minutes.

Pumpkin Bread

5 eggs, well beaten	4 1/2 tsp. cinnamon
3 c. sugar	1 1/2 tsp. nutmeg
2 1/2 c. canned pumpkin	1 1/2 tsp. cloves
4 1/2 c. corn oil	1 tsp. ginger
4 1/2 tsp. salt	1 1/4 c. milk choc. chips
1 1/2 tsp. baking soda	

Preheat oven to 350. Grease & flour four 2x5 loaf pans. Cream eggs & sugar. Add pumpkin & oil, mixing slightly. Sift dry ingredients together & add to pumpkin mixture; combine thoroughly. Fold in chips. Pour into loaf pans & bake for 45 min.

Combine:	Combine:
1/2 c. oleo	2 1/2 c. flour
1/2 c. oil	4 tbsp. cocoa
1 3/4 c. sugar	1/2 tsp. salt
3 eggs	1/4 tsp. cloves
1 tsp. vanilla	1 tsp. cinnamon
	1 tsp. baking soda
	1/2 tsp. baking powder

Add flour mixture to sugar mixture with 1/2 c. butter milk. Spoon in 2 c. zucchini grated. Sprinkle on the top 1/2 c. brown sugar, chocolate chips, and 1 c. nuts (optional). Pour into a well greased 9x13 pan. Bake uncovered at 350 for 45 minutes.

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


BOOK CLUB
